Racing Rules and Comments

Final classes, starting order and any official notices will be posted at the tent by 9:00 a.m. Saturday.

Allocation of entrants into A & B divisions shall be the responsibility of the class, except Handicap Keel/PHRF, which allocation shall be determined by the Chairman and Race Committee based on pre-registrations.

PHRF boats with 5 or more pre-registered entrants may sail as a class.

Race packets will include Sailing Instructions and Race Course Charts with revised courses. Racing will be governed by the Rules of Sailing (2001-2004). However, please refer to Sailing Instructions for starting system.

Races will be scored using the Low Point System. All races count.

Personal flotation is required by the U.S. Forest Service and must be worn at all times while racing.

All times will be based on the atomic clock.
