Classes will be determined by registrations received by May 21.

Regatta Participant Camping

REGATTA PARTICIPANTS are required to pay the \$5 per day per vehicle use fee during the Whiskeytown Regatta activities period. Use fees may be paid at the Visitors Center or at machines in the parking lot near the launch ramp. Your use permit must be displayed in the windshield of your vehicle

BRANDY CREEK MARINA PARKING LOT RV camping in the last three, southern most rows of parking in the main section of the Brandy Creek Marina parking area if authorized for camping use by regatta participants, first come first served, from Noon May 23 until Noon May 26. All RV units must capture their gray water. **No open fires or tents** are permitted in this area. This space is limited, so limit your space occupancy and leave room for others. **Do not** camp in any other area of this parking lot.

TENT CAMPING Dry Creek Group Campground is reserved, with no additional fee, for Regatta participants. This reservation runs from noon on Friday, May 23, through noon on Monday, May 26. This camp is primitive-type. It is located just beyond the Brandy Creek developed area. Vehicles are prohibited in this area except to load or unload equipment and must be immediately returned to an adjacent parking area. The access roads must remain open for official use at all times. This is BEAR COUNTRY please store food safely. Fires are permitted only in designated fire pit areas. If you want a fire, please bring your own firewood. *Campground regulations will be provided at Regatta Registration.*

BRANDY CREEK RV CAMPGROUND RV units may camp at Brandy Creek RV Campground, no hookups. The camping fee for this area must be paid by individual campers at the Brandy Creek Marina fee machine or the Visitors Center at the NE entrance road. A camping receipt must be displayed conspicuously on each RV while camping in this area and all rules adhered to. All RV units must capture their gray water. No open fires or tents are permitted in this area. This area will remain open to the general public and is available only on a space available, first come basis. Boats and trailers must be parked in the Brandy Creek Marina parking lot. *Campground regulations will be provided at Regatta Registration.*

OAK BOTTOM CAMPGROUND Oak Bottom is a concessionaire operated campground with both tent and RV spaces. Reservations may be made through the NATIONAL PARKS RESERVATION SERVICE by calling 1-800-365-CAMP. Reservations may also be made at the Internet address RESERVATIONS.NPS.GOV.

MOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS in any price range are available in the Redding area.

QUIET HOURS in all camping areas are 10 p.m. to 6 am and must be observed.

Marina and Camping National Park Service Rules

This regatta is sponsored by **Whiskeytown Sailing Club** with permission to use these facilities granted by the National Park Service. **The National Park Service** requests that you observe the following items as conditions for our Special Use Permit.

All regatta participants are required to pay a \$5.00 per day Daily Use Fee per vehicle, boat trailers excluded. You may purchase multiple days. The pass must be displayed in your windshield at all times. This pass can be obtained at the Visitors Center upon entering the Whiskeytown Recreation Area. An Annual Pass may be purchased for \$20.

Golden Age Passports are honored.

RV units must capture their gray water at all times while in the park.

Proper food storage practices must be strictly adhered to in ALL areas to prevent conflicts with wildlife. **THIS IS BEAR COUNTRY.**

Vessels tied or moored in the “marina area” must remain outside the log-boomed concession area and must not be tied to the log boom. Vessels may be tied on-shore, anchored and/or moored in the Brandy Creek area, so long as they do not disrupt normal visitor activities.

Vessels without current registration stickers and (resident State) numbers properly displayed, will not be allowed to participate in any event or launch on Whiskeytown Lake. Vessels must carry all safety equipment as required by law.

All pets must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 ft.

Regatta participants must check and observe National Park Service rules.

Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla 39 is supporting the Regatta, by providing chase boats and crews. They are also assisting with on the lake communications. When you see them on the lake, give them a wave. Thank you Coast Guard Auxiliary.
