

Attention Lido 14 "B" Sailors!

Balboa Yacht Club invites you to The 2008 Ullman B Lido 14 Racing Clinic & Regatta Sunday October 19, 2008

This event consists of two components: a Lido 14 racing clinic and a regatta. Both are free. The Ullman B perpetual trophy will be awarded to the top skipper of the Regatta. Please read the following Notice of Race for further details.

- 1. RULES:** This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined by the current Racing Rules of Sailing and the class rules of the Lido 14 Class Association.
- 2. DIVISIONS:** Lido 14 B.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY:** **The clinic is open to all sailors.** The regatta is open to Lido 14 Class Association members and clinic participants who are not "A" sailors, as is defined by the Lido 14 Class Association Rules*. In other words, if you are not a member and want to compete, you must take part in the clinic too.
- 4. LOCATION:** Registration and the Regatta Skippers Meeting will be held on the Balboa Yacht Club (BYC) Flag Deck. The location of all other on-shore events (clinics, awards, etc.) will be at BYC at locations to be announced at Registration. On the water activities will be held on Newport Harbor in the vicinity of BYC.

- 5. SCHEDULE:** Three (3) races are scheduled for the Regatta of which one (1) shall be completed to constitute a series. The Low Point System will be used except that no score will be excluded. The schedule of events is as follows:

The event will start with a general meeting at 1000 hours on the Flag Deck. The remaining schedule for the day is flexible and will include clinic events (both on and off the water) and racing. There will be a lunch break. We will continue until approximately 1600 hours (again, flexible).
- 6. REGISTRATION:** To register for the Regatta, competitors must complete an entry form (provided at the event) before the first warning signal. Sailing Instructions and course charts will be available at that time too.
- 7. ENTRY FEE:** **NONE!**
- 8. FACILITIES:** The hospitality of BYC and its facilities, **except on site automobile parking**, are extended to all competitors. Each boat must be equipped with an internal sling for use with the dinghy hoist (South Boat Yard Hoist).
- 9. TROPHIES:** The Ullman B perpetual trophy will be awarded for first place in the Regatta.

* Basically, everyone starts out life unrated and can race either "A" or "B". Once you win a "B" regatta with 10 or more boats in the contest, you are assigned to the "A" category. Once an "A", you stay there for 13 months before you are eligible to race "B" again (presuming you haven't retained "A" status thru another means). If in doubt, call or email.
