Notice of Race

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as define in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2 ENTRIES

2.1 Eligible boats and Snipe Class member skippers may enter by completing registration with the Mission Bay Snipe Fleet the morning of May 17th. The Lido Regatta is open to all members of the Lido-14 Association sailing a Lido-14 and guests of the Lido-14 Fleet 7 Fleet Captain.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 Registration will be from 08:00 until 11:30 on Saturday, May 17th
- 3.2 There will be a competitors meeting at 10:45 am Saturday morning.
- 3.3 Six Races are scheduled.
- 3.4 The first warning will be at noon each day.
 - 3.4.1 Subsequent races will follow ASAP with 3 races scheduled on each day. The Race Committee has the option of modifying the Schedule.
- 3.5 A lunch break will be signaled by the R/C by flying code flag R at the finish.
- 3.6 No warning signal will be made after 3:30 pm Sunday.

4 RACING AREA

Racing will be held in the Sail Bay part of Mission Bay.

5 THE COURSES

5.1 The courses will windward/leeward with possible triangles.

6 RECALLS

An attempt will be made to hail OCS boats. Failure to be hailed, the timing of such a hail, or failure to hear a hail is insufficient cause for redress under RRS 62.

7 TIME LIMITS

The time limit for the first boat to finish will be 90 minutes. Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored Did Not Finish. This changes rule 35.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply
- 8.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.3 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.4 RRS 62 is modified such that a violation of RRS 29.1 (OCS) shall not be dropped if unsuccessfully contested by the infringing competitor and the protest is deemed to be frivolous by the Protest Committee whereupon the OCS shall be scored DNE.

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew for the top 5 places for the Snipes, the top 2 places for the Lido A fleet, and the top 2 places for the Lido B fleet.
