Notice of Race

March 1-2, 2008



1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Newport Harbor Yacht Club (NHYC).

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Lehman 12(A and B Fleets), Lido 14(A and B Fleets), Harbor 20(A and B Fleets), Santana 30/30, Santana 20, and Schock 35 boats. Five (5) boats are required to constitute a class eligible for a start and trophies. Other interested One-Design classes may be invited to sail at the sole discretion of the OA and are encouraged to contact the NHYC Race Director prior to February 15, 2008.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the entry fee online at www.nhyc.org.

- 3.3 A representative from each boat must check-in with the Regatta Office at NHYC on Saturday, March 1, 2008, between 0800-1000.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in at NHYC.

6. RACING AREAS

- 6.1 Lehman 12, Lido 14, and Harbor 20 boats will race in the harbor north of the NHYC Main Dock.
- 6.2 Santana 20, Santana 30/30, and Schock 35 boats will be racing in the ocean off Newport Beach.

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7. THE COURSES

The courses for all classes will be windward -leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course. A leeward gate may be used at the Race Committee's discretion.

8. SCORING

8.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to class winners based on the number of entries on Sunday, March 2, 2008, as soon as possible after the last race.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

PARKING

The NHYC parking lot is for members and regatta participants only. Regatta participant parking passes will be issued at registration to visiting competitors. RV/Campers are not allowed in the parking lot. Please note that trailers parked on the street must be attached to a car. Parking in the alley is not allowed and the Newport Beach police department will issue tickets.

MOORING AND DRY STORAGE

Boat owners will be offered free mooring, rafting or dry storage at the NHYC from February 28 – March 4, 2008. For extended stays a fee of \$ 0.40 per foot per day will apply and boat owners will need to make arrangements with the Dockmaster via email at dockmaster@nhyc.org. NHYC has two hoists which competitors will be allowed to use. Boat owners will need to provide their own slings.
