General

Lido 14 Fleet 80 Seattle and Lake Sammamish Yacht Club, extend an invitation to all Lido 14 sailors and guests to participate in the 2009 Lido 14 Fleet 80 Championship Regatta on October 25, at Lake Sammamish in Bellevue WA. This is the first regatta for Fleet 80 in recent years, and the first Lido class regatta on Lake Sammamish. We hope other fleets will join us in our inaugural regatta.

1. RULES

1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) is Lido 14 Fleet 80 – Seattle.

1.2. The regatta is governed by the ‘rules’ as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association.

2. DIVISIONS

2.1. A single Lido 14 division will be raced

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

3.1. This regatta is open to all Lido 14 sailors. Members of Lido 14 Fleet 80 – Seattle fleet, will be scored both separately and with overall scoring.

3.2. Competitors wishing to enter shall complete the regatta entry form and deliver it to LSYC Race Committee before the end of the Registration period listed below. An email advisory or call to the Commodore by participants would be appreciated to help with planning.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at the LSYC Registration.

5. LOCATION

5.1. All non racing related events will be held at LSYC Commodores’ dock at 1408 W. Lake Sammamish Pkwy. SE, Bellevue WA 98008 (425) 449-0070 (M) (425) 747-7246 (H) or Vasa Park.

5.2. Racing area will be northeast of Vasa Park.

6. FACILITIES

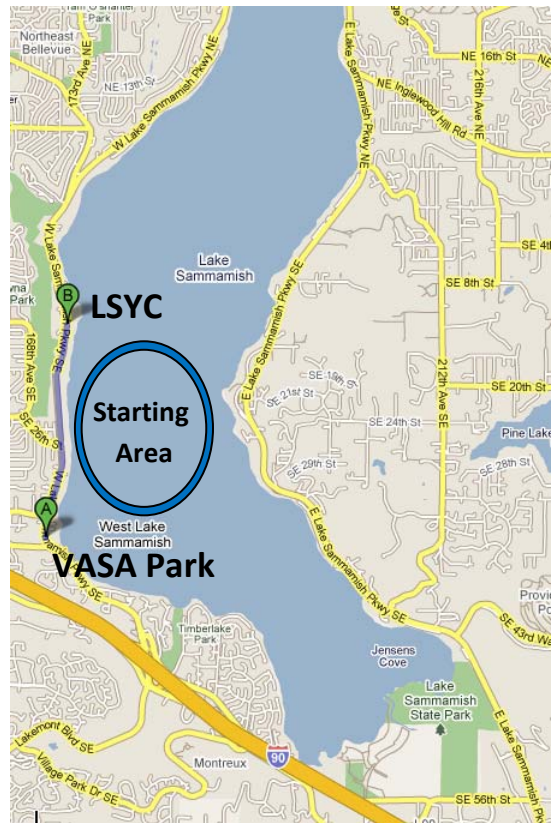
6.1. Competitors may launch their boat at Vasa Park ramp. Vasa Park Resort 3560 W. Lake Sammamish Pkwy. SE, Bellevue WA 98008 425-746-3260 <http://www.vasaparkresort.com/>. Directions from I-90: Take Exit #13 and follow West Lake Sammamish Pkwy S.E. north for approximately 1 1/4 miles. The park is on the right. Drive through the chain link gate. Pay \$7 launch/parking fee. We will park and meet near the boat ramp.

Dock space is very limited here so boats may be sailed/towed to the commodore's docks 1.4 miles north (to be finalized depending on number of entries and weather).

7. SCHEDULE

7.1. Five (5) races are scheduled but one race will constitute a regatta (one throw-out planned if four or more races completed).

7.2. A break may be provided mid-way thru the racing based on weather conditions and actual start time.
