Rules: This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the one-design class rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any Amendments and Notices issued by the Race Committee. RRS 44.2 is changed to a 360-degree turn including one tack and one gybe. RRS 40 will be changed to apply regardless of whether code flag "Y" is displayed.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to all Lido 14's.

Entries: Entries must be received by *Saturday, April 2, 2005, at 1000 hours.* Competitors who have not reached their eighteenth (18th) birthday must also have their entry forms signed by a parent or guardian.

Fees: The entry fee is \$15. Checks should be payable to SCCYC. Race entries may be deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the <u>southwest wall</u> near the bottom of the stairs to the SCCYC Clubhouse or mailed to 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Fleet 2 web site (www.lido14fleet2.org) no later than Saturday, March 26, 2005 and will be available at SCCYC no later than 0900 hours on Saturday, April 2, 2005.

Skippers meeting: A mandatory skippers' meeting will be held at SCCYC at 1000 hours the day of the race and any notices to competitors will be given at that time.

Starting Time & Location: The first race will start at 1200. Racing will be inside Marina del Rey harbor between the "No Sail" lanes of the outer entrance channel.

Course: The courses will be published in the sailing instructions.

Trophies and Hospitality: The hospitality of SCCYC is available to all participants. Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race. Free food and cash donation bar will also be available.

Launching: A 1 ton hoist is available at SCCYC. Boats using hoist must have their own internal sling. A public launch ramp is also available across the street from SCCYC for a fee (\$7.00). Entrance is machine operated. Exact change is suggested.

Parking: Car and trailer parking is available at SCCYC for free or at the public launch ramp parking lot for a fee.
