Lido 14 Fleet 1 – Newport Beach, CA, Rogue Yacht Club, and Regatta Chairman John Papadopoulos extend an invitation to you to participate in the 2005 Lido 14 Class Championship Regatta this coming August 1st thru 3rd on Howard Prairie Lake, Oregon. This event will immediately follow the July 30th and 31st running of the 2005 Howard Prairie Regatta (hosted by Rogue Yacht Club.)

Howard Prairie Lake, the location of the 1999 Lido 14 Class Championships, is located at the 4600' elevation in the picturesque mountains east of Ashland, Oregon. We encourage all Lido sailors, regardless of age or skill, to participate in the Class Championship Regatta and, for those wishing additional time on the water, to compete in the Howard Prairie Regatta too.

1. Organizing Authority

- 1.1. The organizing authority for this regatta is the Lido 14 Class Association and Lido 14 Fleet 1 – Newport Beach, CA.

2. Rules

- 2.1. The Lido 14 Class Championship Regatta (“Regatta”) is governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2. The Regatta is restricted to Category A advertising.

3. Divisions

- 3.1. This regatta will be sailed as the Lido 14 Class Championships. A Junior Division is not included in this event. Note, however, that there is no age restriction for competing in this event.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1. The Regatta is open to all 2005 members of the Lido 14 Class Association who meet the Association By-Law requirements for competing in the Class Championship Regatta including, but not limited to, Class By-Law Article XVII.3 which states that competitors shall have actively and legally raced a Lido 14 sometime between 1958 and June 2nd, 2005 (i.e. at least sixty days prior to the Regatta) to be eligible for this Regatta.

5. Schedule of Events

- 5.1. The Lido 14 Class Championship Regatta consists of two separate and distinct series: the Qualifying Series and the Championship Series. The Championship Series is divided into Gold and Silver Flights with the winner of the Gold Flight being awarded the title of 2005 Lido 14 Class Champion. The sole purpose of the Qualifying Series shall be to generate a ranking of competitors that, in turn, shall be used for assigning competitors into the Gold and Silver Flights. Details of the ranking system, flight assignment system, and scoring systems to be used will be published in the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2. The Qualifying Series is scheduled to have three (3) races.
- 5.3. The Championship Series is scheduled to have eight (8) races.
- 5.4. The schedule of events is as follows:

6. Entry Fee

- 6.1. The Entry Fee includes two (2) tickets for the Annual Meeting Dinner, two (2) tickets for the Awards Banquet, and boat storage fee for four (4) days (Sunday thru Wednesday). Entry Fees are refundable at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 6.2. **ENTRIES RECEIVED PRIOR TO JULY 18TH WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A DRAWING FOR LIDO 14 RACING GEAR TO BE HELD AT THE FLEET 1 WELCOMING PARTY SUNDAY EVENING.**

8. Registration/Check-In

- 8.1. Prospective competitors may enter the Regatta at the Registration Area (see attached Resort Map) during the Registration/Check-In periods listed in the Schedule of Events or they may enter by completing the enclosed Entry Form and delivering it, with the appropriate fees, to:

- 8.2. Entry Forms and Fees not delivered to the above address by July 27th must be submitted at the Registration Area during one of the Registration/Check-In periods.
- 8.3. All competitors must check-in at the Registration Area during one of Registration/Check-In periods in order to submit any fees owed, submit their Measurement Checklist (enclosed), present their Official Certificate of Measurement & Registration, receive regatta materials (sailing instructions, meal tickets, etc.), and to complete competitor and ballast weigh-in. Competitors must complete all these tasks prior to the close of Registration/Check-In to be eligible to compete in the Regatta.

9. Official Notice Board

- 9.1. All official notices will be posted on the Official Notice Board located at the Registration Area.

10. Other Events

- 10.1. Fleet 1 will be hosting a complimentary welcoming party at the Registration Area on Sunday evening at 6:30 P.M.
- 10.2. Fleet 59 (Morro Bay, CA) will be hosting a complimentary party Tuesday evening at 6:30 P.M. Location to be posted.
- 10.3. Two short seminars will be held on Monday and Tuesday nights at 6:00 P.M. The location of these seminars will be posted. Complimentary beverages will be provided at each seminar. The seminar topics are:
- Rigging the Lido 14 for maximum performance
 - Racing Rules of Sailing

10.4. Annual Meeting

- 10.4.1. The Lido 14 Class Association will host the 2005 Annual Meeting at the Group Cookout Area at 6:00 P.M. on Monday August 1st. A buffet style dinner will be served. Vegetarians will be accommodated. There is no dress code. The purpose of the meeting is to conduct official Association business including election of new Class Assn. officers. Contact the Lido 14 Class Association for further details on the agenda of the Annual Meeting.

10.5. Awards Banquet

- 10.5.1. The awarding of championship trophies will occur at a banquet to be held at the Group Cookout Area at 6:30 P.M. on Wednesday night. Vegetarians will be accommodated. Dress is smart casual.

11. Sailing Instructions

- 11.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration/Check-In area during the Registration/Check-In periods listed in the Schedule of Events. The Sailing Instructions will include information on flights to be sailed, courses, scoring, etc.

12. Awards

- 12.1. Take home trophies will be awarded to the top ten (10) finishers of the Gold Flight and the top five (5) finishers of the Silver Flight.
- 12.2. Perpetual trophies will be awarded as described in the Lido 14 International Class Association Handbook:

• W.D. Schock Trophy	Overall winner of International Division
• Warren F. Pomeroy Memorial Trophy	Winner of First Gold Flight Race
• President's Trophy	Winner of Second Gold Flight Race
• Governing Board Trophy	Winner of Third Gold Flight Race
• Longest Journey Trophy	Skipper that travels the furthest
• Fleet 2 Trophy	Winner of Silver Flight
• First Lady Perpetual Trophy	First woman skipper in overall standings
• Jim Tyler Trophy	First Family to Finish
• Grand Master Trophy	First skipper 50 years or older in overall standings
• Team Trophy	Team with lowest team score. The purpose of this trophy is to promote interaction between the members of the Gold and Silver Flights. Teams are created by pairing Gold and Silver Flight boats based upon their rankings Qualifying Series.

13. Measurement

- 13.1. Skipper and crew must present themselves for competitor weigh-in during the same Registration/Check-In period.
- 13.2. Competitors must present all ballast weights not permanently affixed to the competitor's boat for weigh-in during any of the Registration/Check-In periods. A ballast weight is considered permanently affixed if it requires tools to be removed.
- 13.3. A 2005 Lido 14 Class Championship Regatta Measurement Checklist (enclosed) must be completed by your fleet measurer. If you do not have a fleet measurer, you may have your checklist completed by any fleet measurer, the Chief Measurer, or their proxies. Those that cannot locate an eligible measurer shall make an appointment with the Chief Measurer to have their checklist completed at the Regatta. The Chief Measurer can be reached at:

14. Boat Storage

- 14.1. The Resort has a parking/dry storage area located next to the boat launch ramp (see Resort Map) for boaters to store trailers, boats on trailers, rig their boats, etc. The Resort charges a daily fee to use this area; the Regatta Entry Fee includes parking fees for four (4) nights (Sunday night through Wednesday night). To arrange for additional use of the parking/dry storage area, contact the Resort directly. See the Lodging section for contact information.
- 14.2. The Resort rents boat slips for those that wish to leave their boats in the water. Contact the Resort for details.

15. Safety

- 15.1. The organizers of this regatta wish to remind all competitors that the US Coast Guard requires that all recreational boats carry one wearable US Coast Guard approved PFD for each person aboard. The State of Oregon further requires sailboats under 16 feet to carry a sound device, such as a whistle, and that all children 12 years and younger must wear a PFD while the boat is underway. 17. Driving Directions

- 17.1. The regatta site is Howard Prairie Lake, Oregon. Driving directions to Howard Prairie Lake are as follows:

- Take Interstate 5 towards southern Oregon.
- Take Exit 14 (Ashland, OR/Highway 66 Exit) off Interstate 5.
- Take Highway 66 East for approximately 1 mile and turn left onto Dead Indian Memorial Road. There will be a sign at the turn-off for the local (municipal) airport and "Mountain Lakes."
- Travel approximately 17 miles up Dead Indian Memorial Road (about a 20 minute drive) and turn right onto Hyatt Prairie Road. There is a sign for the Howard Prairie Resort at this intersection.
- The Resort is on the left approximately three miles along Hyatt Prairie Road.


