General

Regatta Chairman Bob Hartung, Lido 14 Fleet 73, extends an invitation to all Juniors who are members or guests of the Lido 14 Class Association to participate in the 2006 Lido 14 Jr. Class Championship Regatta this coming September 9-10, at Dana Point, California. The event is being held in conjunction with the Richard Henry Dana Charity Regatta® benefiting Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, sponsored by Dana Point Yacht Club (dpyc.org). This is also the weekend for the popular Toshiba Tall Ships Festival in Dana Point (tallshipsfestival.com).

Rules

The Jr. Class Championship Regatta is governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, the rules of the Lido 14 Class Association, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions), and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility

Any skipper or crew who will not have reached their 19th birthday by December 31st 2006 is eligible to race in the event under one of the following Lido 14 Class Association categories: 1) (Junior Dependent Members) dependent children of Senior members of the Association; 2) (Junior Members) junior members who own their own boat; 3) (Junior Syndicate Member), junior members who are partners in owning a boat; or 4) (Junior Guest) skippers who are not an Association Member, who are guests of their home Fleet for this event only. Class By-Law Article XVII.3, which pertains to having raced Lido 14s 60 days prior to the event, is waived for this event. Class By-Law Article IX.10 (d), which pertains to Guests not competing in a Class Championship, is waived for this event.

Event Locations

Registration/Check-In and the Competitor's Meeting will be held at the Dana Point Yacht Club dry storage yard located at the southeast end of the bridge to Dana Island. Awards will be presented at the Awards Banquet for the Richard Henry Dana Charity Regatta at Dana Point Yacht Club. A boat hoist will be available. Competitor's must provide their own internal lifting harness.

Racing will take place either inside Dana Point Harbor or outside the harbor off of Doheny Beach, depending on weather and wind conditions. Chase boats will be provided for either venue. Spectator viewing is convenient and available along the channel inside the harbor. If the event is held outside the harbor, a limited number of family/guests may be accommodated to view the regatta on spectator boats provided by DPYC.

Entry Fees

The pre-registration entry fee for this event is \$75. The late registration fee, received after September 1, 2006, is \$100. Please make all checks payable to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation who will receive all proceeds from the event. All participants and guests are welcome to attend the Post Race Party and Trophy Presentations at Dana Point Yacht Club on Sunday, September 10.

Registration/Check-In

Participants may pre-register for the Junior Class Championship Regatta by completing an entry form and returning it no later than September 1, 2006 to:

Due to the logistics of hosting the 2006 Jr. Class Championships Regatta, a minimum of 5 boats must pre-register for the regatta to be held. If at least 5 boats pre-register, then late registrations may be accepted no later than the close of the competitor's meeting, Saturday, September 9, 2006.

Measurement

The total minimum weight of skipper, crew and ballast shall be two hundred (200) pounds. All participants **MUST** weigh in at the registration desk during the Registration/Check-In time periods listed in the Schedule of Events.

All boats used in this event must demonstrate compliance to the Class Rules requiring boats and ballast to weigh a minimum of three hundred ten (310) pounds. A valid Official Certificate of Measurement & Registration or a memo from a Fleet Measurer showing the minimum being met, or an actual weigh-in of the boat at the event are sufficient to demonstrate compliance for this event.

Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available during the Regatta Registration/Check-In period noted in the Schedule of Events.

Trophies

Take home trophies will be awarded to the top five (5) finishers. In addition, the W. D. Schock Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the event.
