Notice of Race 2007 Lido 14 District 1 Championship Regatta September 8th and 9th, 2007 Lake Casitas, CA

General

You are invited to participate in the 2007 Lido 14 District 1 Championship Regatta which will be held on September 8th and 9th at Lake Casitas California.

Rules

This regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing

Eligibility

The District Championship Regatta is open to all members of the Lido 14 Class Association as well as guests of Fleet 43. Yachts and teams entered in the regatta will be expected to be in compliance with all Rules and By-Laws of the Lido 14 Class Association.

Location

The regatta will be held on Lake Casitas California. Click link for driving directions: http://www.lakecasitas.info/directions.html. We will sail and launch from the Launch ramp on the North West Side of the Lake (i.e. turn to your right when you enter the Lake Area).

Courses and Scoring

A combination of courses will be used. There will be windward leeward courses as described in the course chart that will be included with your Sailing Instructions as well as several races that will use the island in the center of the lake as the only mark (i.e. we will take the island to either port or starboard). The low point scoring system will be used; however, any and all island races will be scored separately and the results from the island races will be tallied and a boats overall score for the island races will be added to the results of the windward leeward races as one race. In other words, the island races will carry less weight than the windward leeward races. There will be no throw outs for this event.

Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration / Check-in area during registration as well as during the Skippers meeting.

Launch and mooring

We will sail and launch from the Launch ramp on the North West Side of the Lake (i.e. turn to your right when you enter the Lake Area and wind around until you hit the Launch Ramp). There is ample storage for boats overnight at the launch area and the area is patrolled by the rangers.

Camping/Lodging

Areas in Camp Site G have been reserved for this event. There are hotels in both Ojai and Ventura for those not wishing to camp (30 minute drive at the most), Contact Eric Bohman or Mike O'Neill for more info (ebohman1@aol.com, mike@theoneills.net)

Entry Fees

Entry Fee will be \$15 for all competitors not a Member of Fleet 43.

Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to skipper and crew of the top five (5) finishers in the regatta. Only members of the Class Association and a recognized Fleet in District 1 will be eligible for the Honor of District 1 Champion. In other words, no guests of Fleet 43 and no one from a District other than District 1 can win the District Championships.
