10 passenger pontoon, \$ 50 first 2 hours, \$15 per hour additional hours


-We hope to have several people split the cost of a pontoon to watch the race. Approx \$100 for 5 hours (split 5-10 ways) Let me know if you are interested.

Sat. Sept 15 First sequence starts at 12:00PM sharp! Off Lake Approx 4PM Sun. Sept 16 First sequence starts at 11:00AM Off lake by 2PM RACES/ RACE AREA: Race area will be approx 500 Yards directly out from main launching docks. We will run 4-6 races Sat. 2-3 races Sun., based on wind conditions. Courses will be average-long windward-Leeward courses STARTS: 3 Min Sequence. No Flags for any signals. All signals by horn as follows: 4Min Prep-4 short blasts 3Min -1 blast 1Min -1 short blast Start – 1 blast Over early: 2 short blasts..will call out sail # General recall - 4 Blasts RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 2006 Racing Rules of Sailing, and the rules of the class except : The rules below and any changes supplied written or verbally by RC at Skippers meeting. -Hit the pins at start/finish – Clear the line and restart/refinish same direction -Over early -Must Re-clear line and restart -Disputes – PLEASE SETTLE ON THE WATER LIKE GOOD BOYS AND GIRLS -Minor taps/right of way,etc..1-360 before the next mark, ASAP as soon as permitted safely -Big bangs – don't do it ! RC reserves the right to review a formal protest. -Hit a mark – re-round the Mark ! -Start Finish Line is NOT Restricted. Any contact with RC boat, 5MP marker or Pin, do 1-360 ASAP Safely SCORING: Will be by class for the daily trophies. A weekend Trophy is being considered, as well as a perpetual trophy **INVITED CLASSES:** All Lido 14, Race Committee to determine by time of Skippers meeting if we run one or two classes, Based on attendance, skill level, boat type, general vote or whatever the RC wants to and is prepared to run. WEIGHT: We will NOT measure boats.
