Notice of Fall Invitational Regatta

October 27 and 28, 2007

YOU WANT TO KNOW!

1. We are trying some new approaches to scoring the sailing competition. Be sure to read the official part of this notice of race and the sailing instructions!
2. Saturday, after Racing, Lido14 Fleet 7 and the Mission Bay Snipe Fleet will joint host a reception with a keg and hors d'oeuvres; be sure to attend.
3. Early Saturday evening, Lido14 Fleet 7 will host a dinner party at the residence of the Pattersons; the finest of "two buck chuck" and a barbeque tri-tip beef dinner with all the fixins' will be available for the enjoyment of the Lido14 competitors and the R/C. This event is included in the registration fee for this regatta -- no additional cost. Pick up a map to the dinner venue when you check in.
4. Sunday, after racing, Lido14 Fleet 7 will host a chili feed immediately preceding trophy presentations. Drinks at this event will be no-host.

YOU NEED TO KNOW!

1. **Rules.** The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing [RRS] and by the Rules of the Lido 14 Class Association.
2. **Advertising.** Advertising will be restricted to Category A.
3. **Qualified Entrants.** The Regatta is open to all members of the Lido14 Class Association and to invited guests of Lido14 Fleet 7.
4. **Fees.** Fees are as stated in the Registration Form attached.
5. **Registration.** Check in and Registration will be accepted from 8:30 a.m. until 10:15 a.m. on Saturday October 27, 2007 at Mission Bay Yacht Club. Early registrations will be afforded a \$3.00 discount; to qualify, the registration form must be received by the Registrar or be postmarked on or before October 15, 2007.
6. **Time and Date.** Racing will be on Saturday October 27, 2007 with 4 races scheduled and on Sunday October 28, 2007 with 3 races scheduled. Competitor's meeting will be at 10:30 on both Saturday and Sunday. The warning for the first race each day will be at 11:45 a.m. (or as soon

thereafter as determined appropriate by the Race Committee in light of other commitments it may have).

7. **Flights.** On Saturday all entrants will be started together (unless there are 24 or more boats registered). If there are 24 or more boats registered, entrants will be seeded by a Committee appointed by Fleet 7 and divided into color/groups. Each group will compete against each other group and individual scores computed from that competition; in that event scheduled races for Saturday will be reduced from 4 to 3. The standings of the first day's competition will be used to divide entrants into Gold and Silver flights for Sunday's competition in the manner described in Lido14 Class Rules Articles XV paragraph (12). **A and B classifications will be disregarded.** The right of appeal is denied from decisions of the Protest Committee relating to Saturday's competition pursuant to RRS 70.4(a).
8. **Scoring.** Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A. The standing (not score) of each entrant from Saturday will be carried over to Sunday's competition and treated as if there had been an additional race sailed Sunday. All races for Saturday will be scored with no throw-out. If 3 races are in fact completed Sunday (plus the carry-over), there will be one throw-out for Sunday which may be the carryover of position from Saturday. This changes RRS Appendix A2.
9. **Trophies.** There will be trophies for the first four positions in both the Gold and Silver flights based on Sunday's competition. Skipper and crew otherwise qualified will each receive a trophy. The winner of the Gold flight will be awarded the Robert Lesnick Perpetual Trophy.
7. **Venue.** Sailing will be on Sail Bay immediately adjacent to Mission Bay Yacht Club.
8. **Courses.** Courses will be "Tour of the Bay" as described in MBYC "Bay Course Chart".
9. **Sailing Instructions.** Sailing instructions will be distributed at check-in.
