Important Stuff

1. <u>Rules</u>. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

- 2. <u>Eligibility</u>. The regatta is open to all members of the Lido Class Association and guests of Lido 14 Fleet 7. MAKE NO MISTAKE PARTICIPATION IN THIS REGATTA <u>IS NOT</u> RESTRICTED TO MEMBERS OF YACHT CLUBS WITHIN DISTRICT ONE!
- 3. <u>Fees</u>. The registration fees will be as shown on the Regatta Registration.
- 4. Qualification. All registrants will compete from a single start in racing on Saturday ["Be kind to your Marshmallow-Series"] with the top one-half to sail on Sunday in competition in "There Ain't No Marshmallows Here-Series" and the bottom half to sail on Sunday in "The Marshmallow Series".
- 5. <u>Registration</u>. Pre-registration must be received or post-marked on or before October 20, 2008; Registration and check-in closes 10:15 a.m. Saturday.
- 6. <u>Measurement</u>. All registrants must certify that their boat complies with the Lido 14 Class Rules and that the combined weight of the skipper and crew (plus any ballast) is not less than 300 pounds.
- 7. <u>Schedule</u>. There will be a skipper's meeting at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday. Warning for the first race will be at 11:55 each day. Three races are scheduled for Saturday and three on Sunday. One race makes a regatta.
- 8. <u>Scoring</u>. The <u>position</u> of each competitor from Saturday's sailing will be carried over to Sunday. If three races plus the carry-over are sailed on Sunday, there will be one throw out on Sunday. This changes RRS A2.

- 9. <u>Venue</u>. All races will be sailed on Sail Bay adjacent to Mission Bay Yacht Club, 1214 El Carmel Place, San Diego, Ca. We will be sharing the bay with our friends from the Snipes but we will have our own courses.
- 10. <u>Sailing Instructions</u>. Sis will be available at the Lido Website by September 30, 2008 and at sign-in.
- 11. <u>Trophies</u>. Trophies for the Fall Invitational will be presented as determined appropriate by the host. Trophies are being prepared by Pam Fairley. The best finisher from district One in the "There ain't no Marshmallows Here" series will receive a Silver "L.
