# Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club (SMWYC) and Lido 14 Fleet 2 present the

# 2008 Super Bowl Regatta Sunday, January 27, 2008

1. **Rules.** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)* which include the rules of the participating one design classes.

# 2. Eligibility and entry.

- 2.1. This event is open to members of the Lido 14 Class Association, guests of Lido 14 Fleet 2, and the Marina del Rey Capri 14.2 and Laser Fleets.
- 2.2. The entry fee for regatta is \$10.00 and is payable to SMWYC with cash or check.
- 2.3. The entry deadline is 1000 hours on the day of the regatta.
- 2.4. Entry the day of the regatta will be available at SMWYC.
- 2.5. Entry prior to the day of the regatta is available by mailing the event entry form to SMWYC at the address listed below such that the entry arrives by Saturday January 26<sup>th</sup>. The Entry form will be posted on the SMWYC (www.smwyc.org) and Lido 14 Fleet 2 websites (www.lido14fleet2.org).
- 3. **Divisions.** The organizing authority will determine what divisions (e.g. Lido 14 A and Lido 14 B) will be offered based on the registration information at the close of the entry period, whether divisions will be sailed together or separately, and the order of starts at the conclusion of the entry period. Divisions and order of starts will be announced at the skipper's meeting.

#### 4. Location.

4.1. All non-racing events will be held at the SMWYC clubhouse which is located at:

- 4.2. Racing will be held in the Outer Channel of Marina del Rey.
- 4.3. Course charts and Sailing Instructions will be available at SMWYC prior to the skipper's meeting.

# 5. Schedule.

- 5.1. A skipper's meeting will be held at SMWYC at 1000 hours the day of the regatta.
- 5.2. The warning signal for the first start will be at 1200 hours (noon). The race committee will try to get in as many races as possible. Five races are probable with a short break after the second race.
- 5.3. No race shall start later than 1545 hours.

#### 6. Scoring.

- 6.1. The Low Point System in RRS Appendix A shall apply except that no scores shall be excluded.
- 6.2. Two races completed shall constitute a series.

### 7. Launching.

- 7.1. Launching hoists are available at both SMWYC, and South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club (SCCYC), 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, <a href="https://www.sccyc.org">www.sccyc.org</a>. Competitors wishing to use either hoist shall provide their own internal boat lifting sling.
- 7.2. Boats may also be trailer launched at a public launch ramp across from SCCYC for a fee of \$7.00.
- 8. **Awards.** Results and awards shall be presented at the SMWYC Clubhouse following racing and haul out of competing boats.
