1.0 RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority, "OA" will be the Lido Class Association with implementation by Lido 14 Fleet 7.
- 1.3 The Following Racing Rules of Sailing are changed for this event:
 - 1.3.1 RRS 27.2 is modified to allow posting the course prior to the preparatory signal.
 - 1.3.2 RRS 35 is modified such that boats failing to finish within 15 minutes of the first boat will be scored DNF.

2.0 ADVERTISING:

Advertising will be restricted to Category A as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012

3.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

3.1 The regatta is open to all members of the Lido 14 Class Association qualified as described in paragraph 3 of Article XVII of the Lido 14 Association Class By- Laws sailing Lido14 Class sailboats as defined in Articles XI, XII, XIII, XIV and XV of the Lido 14 Class Association Bylaws. At check-in each entrant must present an original measurement certificate for his or her boat and must also present a Regatta Measurement Check List duly completed and signed by the Measurer of the Fleet of which he or she may belong (or by the Class Measurer or his proxy for non-fleet members). Each entrant must receive an "o.k." to race by the Chief Measurer or his representative or his proxy and by the Regatta Race Committee. All boats will be weighed as part of the check-in process even if they were weighed by a Fleet Measurer.

3.2 Eligible competitors may enter by completing the accompanying entry form and mailing it to:

There will be no on-line registration available for this regatta.

3.3 Early registration means that registration fees and the registration form are in the hands of Lido 14 Fleet 7 on the due date: Early registrations will gualify no later than July 24, 2009.

4.0 FEES:

The Registration fee for the regatta is \$210.00 less a \$6.00 discount for U. S. Sailing Members. The fee includes all charges for skipper, crew at all events except lunches, and bar service; those will be available at Club prices. Two Regatta T-shirts with a custom logo by **Roger and Pat Tilton** will be provided <u>to each qualifying early registrant</u>.

5.0 QUALIFYING SERIES AND CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES:

The Regatta will consist of a Qualifying series and a Championship series managed as provided in the Class By-Laws.

8.0 COURSES

The courses will be windward-leeward or triangles.

9.0 SCORING:

9.1 The standings in the Qualifying Series will be carried forward as race #1 of the Championship series.

9.2 Races 2 thru 7 of the Championship series will be raced on Tuesday and Wednesday.

9.3 For the Qualifying Series, three races are scheduled with one race to constitute a regatta. For the Championship Series 7 races (including the carry-over) are scheduled with two races to constitute a regatta. If fewer than 6 races are sailed in the Championship Series (including the results carried forward), a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9.4 Subject to the approval of the Lido 14 Class and for the Qualifying Series only, the decisions of the protest committee for that Series will be final as permitted by RRS rule 70.5.

10.0 PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded in accordance with the Class Championship By-Laws; there will be ten (10) awards for the Gold Flight and five (5) awards for the Silver with both skipper and crew to be honored in the Gold and Silver Flights.
