

Notice of Race for Balboa Yacht Club's

Ullman B Lido 14 Clinic & Regatta



Sunday October 10, 2010

1. RULES:	This regatta is governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
2. CLASSES:	Lido 14 - "B" Division/Flight only*
3. ELIGIBILITY:	 Skippers shall be either: 2010 members of the Lido 14 Class Association that are eligible to race in "B" Flights* or Non-members of the Lido 14 Class Association invited to compete as Guests. Requests for an invitation shall be sent to the Regatta Chair. See contact details below. Crews shall not have previously registered as a skipper in a Lido 14 "A" flight event.
4. LOCATION:	 Balboa Yacht Club (BYC) is located at 1801 Bayside Drive, Corona Del Mar, CA 92660 and on the web at <u>www.balboayachtclub.com</u>. Telephone: (949) 673-3515. Registration is at the BYC Sailing Office. The Skippers Meeting will be on the Flag Deck adjacent to the Sailing Office. On-the-water activities will be held on Newport Harbor in the vicinity of BYC. The exact location of all other activities (clinics, awards, etc.) will announced at the event.
5. SCHEDULE:	 Registration at BYC Sailing Office 0930-1200 hours Clinic 1000-1200 hours Skippers Meeting 1230 hours Warning Signal for Race 1 1300 hours Up to four (4) Additional Races ASAP Awards ASAP A maximum of five (5) races will be sailed.
6. SCORING	The Low Point System of scoring shall apply except that no scores shall be excluded. One (1) completed race shall constitute a series.
7. REGISTRATION:	To register for the Regatta, competitors must complete an entry form provided at the event. Sailing Instructions and course charts will be available at that time too.
8. ENTRY FEE:	Free to current members of the Lido 14 Class Association. \$10 per boat for invited guests.
9. FACILITIES:	The hospitality of BYC and its facilities, except on site automobile parking , are extended to all competitors. Each boat must be equipped with an internal sling for use with BYC's boat hoist.
10. AWARDS:	The Ullman B perpetual trophy will be awarded to the highest ranking team (skipper and crew) that are racing eligible members of the Lido 14 Class Association. This trophy remains at Balboa Yacht Club.

* Everyone begins Lido 14 racing unrated and can register for either the "A" or the "B" flight of a regatta. A skipper that wins a "B" flight having 10 or more boats in the contest must thereafter compete in the "A" flight until they meet conditions allowing their return to the "B" flight.
