NOTICE OF RACE

Mission Bay Yacht Club Pete Jefferson Lido 14 Spring Invitational Regatta May 21 and May 22, 2011

Mission Bay Yacht Club is located at 1215 El Carmel Place, San Diego, California, 92109

1. Rules

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the **Racing Rules of Sailing.**

2. Advertising

2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all members of the Lido 14 Class who propose to sail duly measured boats. Guests may participate to the extent permitted by the Lido 14 Class Rules and at the discretion of Fleet 7.

3.2 Any eligible boat may register as "Lido A" or as "Lido B". As participants check in, the selection of each boat will be displayed on a white board. Registrants may switch between "A" or "B" until close of registration. It will make for a better regatta if we can achieve approximately the same number of boats in each class; participants are encouraged to make a fair assessment of their abilities, the condition of their boat, and skipper and crew experience.

4. Fees

4.1 See Registration Instructions below.

5. Schedule

5.1 Check-in's will be accepted on May 21, 2011 at Mission Bay Yacht Club commencing at 8:30 a.m.

5.2 Registrations and check-in must be complete by May 21, 2011 at 10 a.m. at Mission Bay Yacht Club.

5.3 The scheduled time for the first race of each day will be 11:50 a.m. Three races are scheduled for May 21 and three for May 22, 2011. One race completed makes a regatta.

5.4 Unless otherwise signaled, Lido As will start first, followed immediately by Lido Bs. Lido As and Lido Bs may start together in the discretion of the Race Committee.

6. Sailing Instructions.

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be distributed at Check-in.

6.2 Sailing Instructions will also be available on line at the Mission Bay Yacht Club website/Lido 14 Class on or before May 9, and thereafter.

7. Venue.

7.1 The races will be conducted in Sail Bay immediately to the east of the Mission Bay Yacht Club facility.

8. The Courses.

8.1 The courses will be selected by the Race Committee from the most current Mission Bay Yacht Club Bay Course Chart and will be republished in the sailing instructions.

8.2 The course to be sailed will be displayed on a placard on the signal boat no later than the presentation of the <u>Preparatory</u> signal. [This changes Rule 27.1].

8.3 Lido As and Lido Bs may or may not sail the same course, all at the discretion of the race committee.

9. Scoring

9.1 Scoring will be as provided in Appendix A.

- 9.2 There will be one throw-out if all six scheduled races are sailed. [This modifies A2]
- 9.3 Lido As and Bs will be scored separately.

10. Prizes

10.1 There will be six sets of prizes awarded to the boats having the best scores.

10.2 Three prizes will be awarded to the best finishers of the "A" registrants and three to the best finishers of the "B" registrants.

10.3 The skipper and crew of the best finishers will each receive a

prize.

10.4. The Pete Jefferson Regatta perpetual trophy will be awarded to the winner of the Lido "A" competition.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

11. 1 The skipper, crew, and owner of each boat will, as a condition to participation, be required to execute the Mission Bay Yacht Club form of release of liability and hold-harmless.

12. Registration

12.1 Pre-registrants will receive a discount of \$3.00 on their registration fee.

12.3 Pre-registration may be accomplished as follows:

a. By pre-registrants providing, in writing, before May 17, 2011, the following information:

(1) Skipper's name.

(3) The number of extra dinners desired.

(4) Yacht-club affiliation, if any.
